Time Commitment

Successful applicants are expected to devote the appropriate amount of time and effort required to provide leadership for existing ensembles and to maintain high quality Camerata ensembles. The Music Camerata is a group of non-major music scholarship students who perform in a variety of musical combinations for campus events throughout the academic year.

- *Perform in the Camerata and one additional ensemble each semester*
- *Regular attendance at rehearsals and performances*
- *Maintain minimum GPA of 2.75*
- *Must be a full time student (12 credit hours minimum)*

Auditions

Students may audition in person or by sending a video recording to the department. Submit a cover letter and a resume which includes musical training and participation in music activities, and the names and phone numbers of at least two references.

Audition performances should include major and minor scales and two short pieces in contrasting styles (*one slow and lyrical; one faster and more technical*). Students may set up an audition time by calling Dr. Abigail Walsh (217) 206-7549.
